- 5. Belcanfran Presentation: Student exchange program. Belcanfran is a volunteer run reciprocal exchange program. Canadian students are matched with students from Belgium or France. The exchange last for 11 weeks. Students from Europe come first in August and return in November and stay with the matched family. They will attend English school. Canadian students go to Europe at the end of January and stay with the matched family. They return in April. Allows students to be immersed in a second language. Coordinators present information to students and parents, evaluate student candidancy, match student partners and coordinate exchange student's life in the other country. Students are treated as family members, not guests. School is compulsory and students must accept the lifestyle of the family they are matched with. - The bilingual (French/English) gym sign has been ordered. GPV will be the first school in Calgary to have a bilingual gym sign.
- Still working on skateboard/scooter parking.

7. Treasurer's Report

General Account Balance is \$3,738. \$2000 in expenditures have been approved but not spent.

Casino Account Balance is \$61,332. Funds from the next casino are expected by May 2025. \$12,000 in expenditures have been approved but not spent.

There was no meeting this past month. There is a workshop being offered for one member of each school council in February.

9. Casino Update

10. Band Association Update

Winter concert was held Wednesday, Jan 22. The concert was very well attended, there was standing room only. Westwinds fun choir and symphony band joined in. The band association made \$460 from a 50/50 at the concert. Plan to do 50/50s for each future show. Band camps are coming up before spring break. Have approximately \$23,000 in the bank, plan to spend most of it this year. Need to document the agreement between band council and student council with regards to casino funds.

11. Fundraising

Eastern Canada Trip parents are planning to do an online 50/50 fundraiser and a Purdy's chocolate sale. They would like to use school council's AGLC license for the 50/50.

Coco Brooks fundraiser planned for the general account. Will aim to start Feb 6 with a Feb 27 pickup date. Joy to send information for administration to include in the weekly message.

12. New Business

School council has a \$500 gift card to use for parent engagement. Discussed whether the funds could be used for a sign to raise awareness of the school and post ongoing events for parents to see. Or perhaps that should be funded a different way. The card has to be used by June 13. Discussion ensued about engagement of different groups, including newcomers. Talked about a fall meet the school night or an end of year celebration of the various clubs. Discussed clubs being a way for students to feel a sense of belonging with the school.

Motion to approve the Eastern Canada Trip hosting a 50/50 fundraiser using the school council ALGC license. The total amount of funds raised will be put towards the Eastern Canada trip. Motion by Marty, seconded by Christina. Approved.
