6. Treasurer's Report

General Account Balance is \$4,133

Casino Account Balance is \$67,853. Funds from the next casino are expected by May 2025.

7. Key Communicator's Report

There was a Community of School Councils meeting last month. They talked about the effects of the record enrollments, creating a lack of schools and space. One of the major things discussed is there is an opportunity for school council members to take classes. Next meeting is April 23, 2025.

8. Casino Update

GPV was offered an earlier casino, which was accepted. Casino will be February 12/13, 2024. Location is Ace Casino Blackfoot. Volunteers will be organized via signup genius.

9. Band Association Update

Band Association AGM was conducted tonight. They still have some casino funds remaining. Band association and school council will share future casino funds, split to be based on recommendations from school administration.
